

# Factsheet Valente - The Netherlands

#### **National Network of Women's Shelters**

Valente is an umbrella organisation comprising various networks, including the National Network of Women's Shelters. This network consists of Valente members who provide women's shelter and non-residential services.

This particular network has existed since 1985 and has a strong tradition of regional cooperation within a nationwide framework.

The safety of our clients is our top priority. Together, we have developed the **Safety Quality Mark for women's shelters**.



Valente is the national umbrella organisation for organisations that support vulnerable people in our society, including those experiencing homelessness, domestic violence, or living in supported housing.

## Lobby


- Sufficient shelter capacity for victims of domestic violence, using the Istanbul Convention (1 shelter place per 10,000 inhabitants) as a benchmark.
- Specialist **youth care** available for all children in shelters.
- Comprehensive, coordinated national policies to prevent and combat domestic violence (Article 7 Istanbul Convention) under one responsible minister.
- Swift implementation of the **STOP FEMICIDE! action plan** with adequate resources.
- Mandatory screening on women's and children's safety in procedures on **visitation rights and custody**.
- Criminalize psychological violence.
- National helpline for violence against women and domestic violence 116: now!
- Sufficient specialist shelters for victims of **human trafficking**.

2016: entry into force of the Istanbul Convention




Valente is an umbrella organisation with **75 member** organisations.

- 20 offer women's shelter
- 4 offer family shelter

#### **CLIENTS**

Data 2023: Shelter provided to 5,715 clients.





Data 2023

- 1,024 safe shelter places, including 38 for male victims.
- On average **1** place per **17,500** people.
- Nearly 800 more needed to meet Istanbul Convention standards.

**How many days?** A total of **535,000 days** of safe shelter provided.

Average length of stay:

- 12 days in emergency shelter and/or
- 64 days in crisis shelter and/or
- 259 days in long-stay shelter

### **Achieved so far**

- Policy framework for supra-regional placement in women's shelters.
- Standardised risk screening tool and risk assessment toolbox.
- Standard framework and quality mark for women's shelters.
- Assessment framework for safe father-child contact.
- Guideluines for gender-sensitive practice.
